## SCOTT ANDERSON READY FOR ROOKIE PRO MAZDA CAMPAIGN

*"MazdaSpeed driver heads to Circuit of the Americas as newly minted Pro Mazda Championship makes its first trip to North America's newest racing venue"*



Fort Collins, Colorado - Scott Anderson, the 2011 Skip Barber National Champion and former MAZDASPEED Motorsports Development scholarship recipient, heads to the spectacular surroundings of the Circuit of the Americas located in Austin, Texas as the Pro Mazda Championship presented by Cooper Tires kicks off the 2013 season in style. For Anderson, the weekend will be a series of new adventures as he joins a new team and runs on a new track. Over

the off-season the Derek Daly Academy driver signed with multi-time winning Pro Mazda team Juncos Racing of Brownsburg, IN. As the cars roll off this weekend Anderson will officially make the second step on the 'Road to Indy' ladder program as he continues his progress towards the IZOD IndyCar Series.

"Starting the Pro Mazda season at the Circuit of the Americas will be an awesome experience," comments Anderson from his home in Fort Collins, CO. "After testing there last weekend it's easily the nicest track I've ever been to and one of my favorites as well. I'm eager to get the season started and see everything unfold."

Anderson and the Junco Racing team recently completed a successful test at the COTA, which saw Scott running consistently inside the top five throughout the two days. The team is learning a new tire for the 2013 season as Anderson learns a new car and new surroundings. Overall Scott and the team left the track having completed a very productive outing ahead of this weekend's opening two rounds of the 16 round season that will cover nine weekends.

"It's going to be interesting to see how everyone does on the new Cooper Tires," continued Anderson. "I've got a lot of confidence coming into the season. The Juncos Racing guys have been great to work with and I know we are going to be very competitive."

Regarded as one of the top development series in North America, the Pro Mazda Championship presented by Cooper Tires will hit the track this Thursday with a full day of Official Series testing. Friday will see drivers run practice, qualifying and race one. Saturday will conclude the program with another round of qualifying followed by race two.

#### **About Scott Anderson:**

Scott is an expert skier from Fort Collins, Colorado and a past MAZDASPEED Motorsports Development scholarship winner having won the 2011 Skip Barber National Championship Presented by Mazda (six wins). In the 2012 Cooper Tires USF2000 Championship powered by Mazda, Scott scored two wins, a pole position and set a new lap record (Road America) on his way to finishing third in the season's championship. Scott is backed by Laser Nail Centers and Neuropathy Testing Centers of Colorado and is a Derek Daly Academy managed driver.
