## ANDERSON PRIMED FOR RETURN TRIP TO ST. PETERSBURG

*"Currently 3rd in Championship Points, Road To Indy driver heads to familiar surroundings at Florida street circuit to take in the second weekend of the 2013 Pro Mazda Championship."*



Fort Collins, Colorado - Scott Anderson, the 2011 Skip Barber National Champion and former MAZDASPEED Motorsports Development scholarship recipient, will use the experience he

gained in last year's USF2000 Series to his advantage as he looks to run well at this weekend's Honda Grand Prix of St. Petersburg. Following an excellent opening weekend of the 2013 Pro Mazda Championship, Anderson is looking forward to pacing the #44 Juncos Racing/Laser Nail Centers/Neuropathy Testing Center/Foot Surgery Center of Northern Colorado car around the concrete confines of the first of four street races on the 2013 calendar. The Juncos Racing team will field two entries and have a solid track record of success on street circuits over the past seasons. This puts Anderson in an excellent position to keep his early season momentum moving forward.



"I'm feeling good coming into this weekend at St. Pete," comments Anderson. "I was struggling a little during testing and at Circuit of The Americas with the tires but I think we found some things that helped a lot and enabled us to post some of the fastest times during the race. Having been to St. Pete before, and now starting to feel very comfortable in the Pro Mazda car, I'm looking forward to getting straight down to business and pushing a bit harder this weekend. Everyone else will be upping their game as well so it won't be easy, but I think we made some huge improvements that will show when we get on track this weekend."

Anderson sits in a three-way tie for third place in the championship point standings thanks to solid runs in the opening two rounds that took place at the new, ultra modern Circuit of the Americas in Austin, Texas. A solid run in race one had Anderson battle forward to sixth position and in race two he bettered that result to take a fourth place finish. Most importantly Anderson was able to set the second fastest lap time in race two, showing the speed the team had been looking to find.



This weekend's races are at 1:10 PM EDT on Saturday, March 23rd and 3:00 PM EDT on Sunday, March 24th, and can be monitored via live timing on the ProMazda website at; <http://www.promazdachampionship.com/timing/>

Scott is an expert skier from Fort Collins, Colorado and a past MAZDASPEED Motorsports Development scholarship winner having won the 2011 Skip Barber National Championship Presented by Mazda (six wins). In the 2012 Cooper Tires USF2000 Championship powered by Mazda, Scott scored two wins, a pole position and set a new lap record (Road America) on his way to finishing third in the season's championship.
