### ANDERSON PRIMED FOR PROGRESS AT POCONO

*Fort Collins, Colorado* - Scott Anderson, extreme sport enthusiast and race winning Road to Indy athlete, is set and ready to head to the granite state of Pennsylvania for this weekend's Cooper Tires Indy Lights Championship race at Pocono Raceway. The series has been on the sidelines for six weeks and will hit the track this weekend for their second straight 2.5 mile oval race. Oval, may not be an accurate description of the highly unique triangle shaped layout that doesn't have a turn four. Anderson, who sits 10<sup>th</sup> in the points in his rookie season of Indy Lights, is coming off a strong run at the Indianapolis Motor Speedway where he ran the Fan

Force United #24 Anderson Podiatry Centers; Laser Nail Therapy, Surgery, and Neuropathy car at speeds in excess of 184 miles per hour, completing all 40 laps of the Freedom 100.

"It's been a long break and I'm very eager to get back in the car," comments Anderson from his new home base of Indianapolis. "I've been thinking about it every day for the last month, especially after our disappointing finish at the Freedom 100."



With racing action back under way, Anderson is excited about the busy calendar over the next eight weeks. With the series hitting the halfway mark, drivers will run seven rounds, racing at five different venues on three different types of tracks. Making the Mazda Road to Indy unique is the mix of oval, road course and street tracks that test the depth of drivers and teams. Following Pocono, drivers head to Toronto for a street battle, followed by Mid-Ohio and a fast flowing road course, then to Milwaukee for a 1-mile oval shoot-out and finally to Sonoma for a rolling, hillside road course.

"We all want to come back strong and everyone's been working hard to make sure that happens," continues Anderson. "The team found a couple significant things that should really improve our speed so we should be very competitive when we unload in Pocono. The rest of season is going to be flat out."

The Fan Force United #24 Indy Lights team will make the run east to the hills of northern Pennsylvania and join the rest of the Cooper Tires Indy Lights Championship competitors as part of the IndyCar weekend of racing. Cars hit the track on Friday for a promoter test day followed by a full day of official series competition on Saturday that includes practice, qualifying and a 40-lap, 100-mile feature race.
