ANDERSON READY FOR STREET BATTLE IN TORONTO

"After completing a solid run at the daunting Pocono Raceway, Anderson and Fan Force United will switch gears as they head north of the border for the Honda Indy Toronto"



Fort Collins, Colorado - Scott Anderson, extreme sport enthusiast and race winning Road to Indy athlete, completed a 'big task' when he took on the tricky triangle of Pocono for the first time with no testing. What was hoped to be a day of work up and data collection on the ultra fast and unique three-corner speedway was washed out, leaving Anderson and the #24 Fan Force United IndyLights team to learn on the fly come race day. The team completed the sole practice session on Saturday with good speed as they worked to find the pace needed for qualifying.

Qualifying did not go as planned, but the track time was important for working on the three different radius turns. At the drop of the green flag, Anderson held station until a slight bobble on the restart, following a caution period, cost him the all-important tow. Anderson would dash to the finish on the lead lap, in sixth place for a strong freshman effort.

“Even though Indy and Pocono were some of the coolest experiences I've had in a race car, we seemed to be plagued with some pretty terrible luck,” comments Anderson. “We knew with testing washed out the day before it would be an uphill battle for us. It was the first time at Pocono for me and for the team. Overall I think we did well considering the challenge. I'm looking forward to getting back on a street circuit again.”

This weekend the #24 Anderson Podiatry Centers; Laser Nail Therapy, Surgery, and Neuropathy car will hit the street circuit that is home to the Verizon IndyCar Honda Indy of Toronto. The 11-turn, 1.75 mile circuit runs through Exhibition Place and rockets down Lakeshore Boulevard. Tight and twisty, fast and flowing, the city center circuit has it all and puts the challenge on the drivers and teams to get it right.

“Toronto was one of my favorites last year. It's a great street circuit and the atmosphere there is awesome,” continues Anderson. “Having been there before should help with our limited track time. I'm getting pretty tired of just having glimpses of a good finish. This is a track where we should be strong contenders so I really need to put on a good performance.”

The #24 Anderson Podiatry Centers; Laser Nail Therapy, Surgery, and Neuropathy car team heads north across the border, taking to the track on Friday for one session of practice. Saturday will see one more round of practice in the morning followed by qualifying in the afternoon. Sunday features a 45-lap dash to the checkered flag.

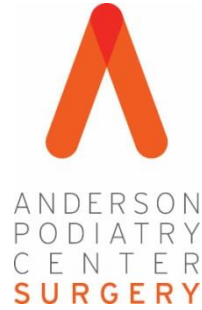
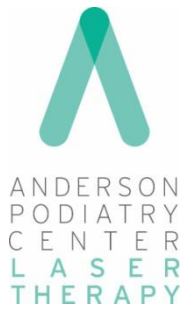
NBC Sports Network will be airing the Toronto Lights Race on Sunday, July 20th at 6:00PM EDT.
