## ANDERSON SEARCHING FOR MID-OHIO MOMENTUM

*"A wet and wild Honda Indy Toronto sees Anderson run well with team and driver now focused on a solid run in the rookie's Indy Lights campaign."*



Fort Collins, Colorado - Scott Anderson, extreme sport enthusiast and race winning Road to Indy athlete, survived the changing conditions and multiple schedule changes to pull together a strong performance north of the border. The #24 Fan Force United Indy Lights team was excited to be back to a street circuit as the number of rounds left in the 2014 championship begins to dwindle. Mother Nature decided to play havoc on the popular street race in Canada's largest city, making for tricky conditions on an ever-changing temporary street circuit. Anderson and the #24 Anderson Podiatry Centers; Laser Nail Therapy, Surgery, and Neuropathy car persevered to take home a good run and log some valuable miles.

"Toronto ended up quite a bit better than it started for us," commented Anderson. "We were really struggling to find speed in practice. We made some pretty big changes going into qualifying but I never got a traffic-free lap until the rain hit, so we didn't really know where we were. I had a great start after dodging some first lap incidents and after a great race long battle with Garcia I ended up P9. Definitely not a great result but we made the most of the situation and found a lot of speed in the car."



Attention now turns to the historic Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course for rounds 10 and 11 of the 14 round championship. Mid-Ohio has been the scene of many strong runs for Anderson as he moves up the Road to Indy ladder. He achieved his first win in the USF2000 Championship there, in 2012. Last season in the Pro Mazda Championship, Anderson tested inside the top four and secured a front row start for Race One by qualifying P2. A mechanical issue ended his race early and he bounced back to P6 in Race Two after starting deep in the field.

"I've always loved Mid-Ohio," continues Anderson. "I got my first USF2000 win there, and was doing great last year in Pro Mazda until a mechanical problem took us out of Race One. We have a good amount of testing and practice time, which we haven't had much of this year. It will be good to do some more fine-tuning and try some things out that we haven't been able to yet."

The #24 Anderson Podiatry Centers; Laser Nail Therapy, Surgery, and Neuropathy car will again join the Verizon IndyCar series as part of a complete Road to Indy program. The 2.258-mile, 13-turn natural terrain course offers a little of everything including elevation changes, speed corners, flowing corners, tight corners, a narrow racing ribbon and a challenging entry to pit lane.

The Indy Lights Championship will take in a Promoter Test day on Thursday, followed by one practice session on Friday. Things get busier on Saturday with qualifying in the morning followed by Race One of the double header in the afternoon. Sunday will see Race Two go green just before noon (EDT).
