ANDERSON LOOKING TO MASTER THE MAGIC MILE

"The third and final oval race of Anderson's rookie IndyLights campaign has him, and the Fan Force United #24 Team, looking to finish strong as the season edges to a close."



Fort Collins, Colorado - Scott Anderson, extreme sport enthusiast and race winning Road to Indy athlete, ran well in his most recent round of the IndyLights Championship as he went from the tricky triangle of Pocono Raceway to the twisty terrain of the Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course. Anderson brought the #24 Anderson Podiatry Centers; Laser Nail Therapy, Surgery, and Neuropathy car home to two top ten finishes on his return to a road course with an eighth

place finish in Race One and ninth in Race Two. The #24 Fan Force United IndyLights car completed all the scheduled laps over the four-day event finding speed in each session.

The team must now switch back to speedway mode as this weekend Anderson sets his sights on the Milwaukee Mile, a track that he is familiar with from his season in the Pro Mazda Championship. In his first visit to the flat one mile oval, Anderson took fourth in qualifying and fifth in the race and will look to use that knowledge from last season to help propel the team to their best finish of the 2014 season thus far.

"Milwaukee is the only oval on the schedule that I've got previous experience on, which should be a big help for us," Anderson said, with a smile. "We need to really work on getting up to speed quickly, so we can work on the fine tuning and qualifying well. If we can do that there's no reason we shouldn't be quick. I had a great weekend here last year. It's an awesome place, so I'm just excited to get back in the car and get a good oval result."



The #24 Anderson Podiatry Centers; Laser Nail Therapy, Surgery, and Neuropathy car will again join the Pro Mazda Championship in a full day of testing on Friday. That will be followed by practice and qualifying on Saturday as they once again join the Verizon IndyCar Series. On Sunday morning, Anderson will take the track for a 100-lap feature race in what is expected to be a packed house.
