



ANDERSON LOOKS FOR A STRONG FINALE AT SONOMA RACEWAY

"Fourth place finish at the IndyFest 100 gives Anderson and Fan Force United huge momentum going into final weekend of the 2014 Indy Lights Championship."



Fort Collins, Colorado - Scott Anderson, took up the challenge of the classic one mile oval located on the Milwaukee State Fairgrounds to record his best finish of the season thus far, completing a solid performance for new sponsor MetaSurg. The #24 Anderson Podiatry Centers; Laser Nail Therapy, Surgery, and Neuropathy car was quick right off the trailer as the team completed a full day of testing. Anderson would qualify in the sixth spot in single car qualifying held on Saturday. Anderson ran with the leaders throughout the 100 lap Sunday

feature race. Running in a tight pack in a hotly contested battle for third place, Anderson applied pressure the entire event staying in the battle to the checkered flag. Scott made up one position at the start and by managing his tires, was able to chase down third and fourth positions most of the race until Luis Razia spun out right in front of him.



"Milwaukee was definitely our best race of the season," commented Anderson. "We were strong straight away, posting some quick times in practice, especially on old tires. Going into qualifying we knew we might not have the fastest sticker tire, qualifying car, but we knew we were going to have a good race distance car. We all really wanted a podium, we were running very strong at the end of the race and almost made it happen at the restart but ran out of laps. I'm still

satisfied with fourth, now we need to build on that momentum and really go for a podium at our last couple races in Sonoma. Big thanks to the Fan Force United Team for putting in a ton of work and a flawless performance."

This weekend marks the close of the 2014 Indy Lights Championship as drivers head to the wine country of Northern California to take on the challenging 2.52 mile Sonoma Raceway. Indy Lights will run two races to round out the season giving Anderson a good shot at moving up the final standings. Scott sits eighth in the points tally and is looking to end strong.

The #24 Anderson Podiatry Centers; Laser Nail Therapy, Surgery, and Neuropathy car will again join the other two classes of the Road to Indy series on Thursday for a full day of testing. Official sessions begin on Friday with practice and qualifying. Saturday afternoon will see the start of Race One as they once again join the Verizon IndyCar Series. On Sunday morning, Anderson will take the track for Race Two.
