



ANDERSON READY TO OPEN 2012 USF2000 SEASON

"2011 Skip Barber National Champion set to campaign season following successful winter testing program with Belardi Motorsports."

Fort Collins, Colorado - Scott Anderson, the 2011 Skip Barber National Champion and MAZDASPEED Motorsports Development recipient, will head to Sebring International Raceway for the opening round of the 2012 Cooper Tires USF2000 Series powered by Mazda. The deep field of Championship and National class cars will descend on Sebring to complete a double-header weekend of racing as part of the 12 Hours of Sebring. Anderson completed a solid run at the recent USF2000 Winterfest held at both Sebring and Palm Beach International Raceway where he and Belardi Auto Racing were able to get their first races under their belt. Most recently Anderson and the Belardi Auto Racing team wrapped a successful two-day test at Carolina Motorsports Park. Focused on car development and working through a development program, both Anderson and Belardi are committed to winning and working hard to be at the sharp end of the field throughout the 2012 season.

"Sebring will be a very important race for the team and myself. It's the start of a new season in a new car. There are a lot of things I will be learning about the environment and that we as a team will be learning about each other," comments Anderson as he heads to central Florida. *"So our approach may be a bit different than our approach to the following races this season. It is extremely important that we take-in as much information as possible and learn as much as possible so that we can put it to good use at St. Pete and have a good foundation to start off the season. We all want to win and do as well as we can, and we will definitely be trying. But the important thing is that we finish the weekend with good results and with the car in good shape for St. Pete. We need just as much focus on learning and starting the season off with the foundation we need."*

An expert skier, the Fort Collins, Colorado resident joins the MAZDASPEED Motorsports Development ladder after winning the 2011 BF Goodrich/Skip Barber National Presented by Mazda and will race in the 2012 Cooper USF2000 Championship powered by Mazda with Belardi Auto Racing.
