ANDERSON SIGNS WITH THE MOST SUCCESSFUL TEAM IN INDY LIGHTS HISTORY



Fort Collins, Colorado - Scott Anderson and his supports are absolutely thrilled to announce that he has signed with *the* most successful team in Indy Lights history; Schmidt Peterson Motorsports (SPM). SPM announced today that Scott will join its four-driver lineup in the 2015 Indy Lights Presented by Cooper Tires Championship. Anderson looks to begin a championship contending season as he returns to Indy Lights for a second season.

Anderson, 24, a native of Fort Collins, Colorado, will join SPM for his second year racing in Indy Lights after competing as a rookie in 2014 with Fan Force United. Anderson marks the fourth and final SPM driver to break cover on his 2015 plans and is elated to be part of a championship winning team.

"I'm very excited to be driving for Schmidt Peterson Motorsports for the 2015 season," comments Anderson from the series testing in Palm Beach, Florida. "They have such a great record and so much experience in Indy Lights, it's going to be a huge step forward in my career. I'm just eager to get the season started and see what we can accomplish."

"Last year was a big learning curve," Anderson added. "The big ovals, IMS and Pocono, were a totally different experience. I made a lot of progress in that area. Being a one-car team made it tough every weekend. I had to focus so much more on myself, be much more efficient and sure of my feedback."

The new era of Indy Lights, spurred by a new car and new engine program has already attracted a strong field with SPM. Anderson's three teammates are Americans Ethan Ringel and RC Enerson and British driver, Jack Harvey, the 2014 Indy Lights Championship runner-up. All four SPM Indy Lights drivers will race in the brand new Dallara IL-15 chassis in 2015, making teamwork especially important while learning the new car.



"We are very pleased to have Scott at SPM for 2015," SPM co-owner Sam Schmidt said. "We kept an eye on him throughout 2014, and we think having teammates to gauge off of will be key to his success this season."

An integral part of the program for the past three seasons has been Derek Daly of the Derek Daly Academy. Daly has been instrumental in Anderson's rapid rise through the Road to Indy ranks. He had this to say about Scott's Season:

"Scott showed last season that when in the right environment and with proper equipment, he can deliver the results. Schmidt Peterson Motorsports was looking for a strong second year Indy Lights driver and Scott's potential made him the ideal candidate to sign. We all look forward to his continuing development."

The 2015 Indy Lights Presented by Cooper Tires season begins March 28-29 with two rounds in St. Petersburg, Florida. Anderson Podiatry Centers; Laser Therapy, Surgery, and Neuropathy will back Anderson's No. 77 entry.

An expert skier and avid outdoor enthusiast, the Fort Collins, Colorado resident is on the third and final step of the Mazda Road To Indy. Anderson was the recipient of the MAZDASPEED Motorsports Development Scholarship after winning the 2011 BFGoodrich/Skip Barber National Championship Presented by Mazda. In 2012, Anderson competed in the Cooper Tires USF2000 Championship powered by Mazda winning two races. In 2013, Scott raced in the ProMazda Championship Presented by Cooper Tires with Juncos Racing. In 2014, Anderson completed his rookie season in Indy Lights with Fan Force United. Anderson is sponsored by Anderson Podiatry Centers; Laser Therapy, Surgery, and Neuropathy. He is also a member of the Derek Daly Academy led by former Formula One driver Derek Daly.
