



## ANDERSON HOPING THIRD TIME IS THE CHARM IN TORONTO

**Fort Collins, Colorado** - Scott Anderson, driver of the #77 Schmidt Peterson Motorsports Indy Lights car arrives in Toronto, Canada with the goal of continuing the incredible momentum created from the Freedom 100. Scoring his first Indy Lights podium by taking third at the Indianapolis Motor Speedway, Anderson heads to the Honda Indy Toronto race with an eye on the top step.

I've been eager to get back on a street circuit since the Indy GP," states Anderson. "We haven't had the results on road and street circuits that I think we're capable of. We've been able to run up front and be one of the fastest cars on ovals, but that needs to happen on every track. So I'm really looking forward to getting to work and pushing to be up front this weekend in Toronto."

The Indy Lights field will take to the 1.75 mile, 11-turn circuit that sees cars scream down Lakeshore Boulevard along Lake Ontario for two rounds of racing action. Scott appeared at the lakeside venue in 2013 in Pro Mazda earning a pair of top tens. Last season Anderson took to the streets in his freshman year of Indy Lights, repeating his efforts with another top-ten performance in the lone round of action.

An expert skier and avid outdoor enthusiast, the Fort Collins, Colorado resident is on the third and final step of the Mazda Road To Indy. Anderson was the recipient of the MAZDASPEED Motorsports Development Scholarship after winning the 2011 BFGoodrich/Skip Barber National Championship Presented by Mazda. In 2012, Anderson competed in the Cooper Tires USF2000 Championship powered by Mazda winning two races. In 2013, Scott raced in the ProMazda Championship Presented by Cooper Tires with Juncos Racing. In 2014, Anderson completed his rookie season in Indy Lights with Fan Force United. For 2015, Scott enters his sophomore season in Indy Lights with a new team; Schmidt Peterson Motorsports. Anderson is sponsored by Anderson Podiatry Centers; Laser Therapy, Surgery, and Neuropathy and Hull & Knarr LLP. He is also a member of the Derek Daly Academy led by former Formula One driver Derek Daly.
