## Anderson Ready for Return to Racing at Grand Prix of Houston

*"With a long break since the last race, Anderson and Juncos Racing are keen as they set their sights on a podium result in final event of the 2013 Pro Mazda Season."*



Fort Collins, Colorado - Scott Anderson, the 2011 Skip Barber National Champion and former MAZDASPEED Motorsports Development scholarship recipient, looks to make the most of the final races in his rookie campaign in the Pro Mazda Championship powered by Cooper Tires. Anderson currently sits in fifth place in the championship after 14 rounds of racing action that covered ovals, road courses and street circuits. The Mazda Road to Indy development series joins the IZOD IndyCar Series this weekend as they make a return to the Grand Prix of Houston. The street race around the iconic Reliant Astrodome is making a return to competition following a five-year absence. The last time the Pro Mazda pilots ran was also a street race, with the Grand Prix of Trois-Rivières taking place on August 11th.



"After a very long break in the schedule I'm extremely eager to get back in the car for our last race weekend in Houston," comments Colorado resident Anderson. "Being the end of the season I really want to finish it off on a high note. I think we've proven that we have the speed but haven't been able to pull off as many podiums as we should have and I think we're more than capable of pulling off a win."

Drivers will be challenged over the ten-turn, 1.7 mile temporary street circuit lined with concrete walls and tricky surface changes. Anderson will be pushing the #44 Juncos Racing/Neuropathy Testing Center/Laser Nail Centers/Foot Surgery Center of Northern Colorado car to the limit early in order to set a strong pace for the weekend. With solid finishes in the previous six street races, run on three different temporary circuits, Anderson is searching for a podium result to close out the year.

"Learning the track quickly with our limited track time and then qualifying well will be huge," continues Anderson. "I'm starting to enjoy street circuits more and more and feel like I'm really starting to get them down, so I'm looking forward to really pushing hard this weekend and going for a good result."

Action gets underway on Friday with one round of practice. Saturday will see qualifying and race one followed by the 16th and final race of the season on Sunday morning.

Scott is an expert skier from Fort Collins, Colorado and a past MAZDASPEED Motorsports Development scholarship winner having won the 2011 Skip Barber National Championship Presented by Mazda (six wins). In the 2012 Cooper Tires USF2000 Championship powered by Mazda, Scott scored two wins, a pole position and set a new lap record (Road America) on his way to finishing third in the season's championship.
