**PODIUM RESULT FOR ANDERSON IN CANADA**

*"Juncos Racing driver completes a strong weekend with a second place finish on Sunday on the heels of a fourth place on Saturday"*



Fort Collins, Colorado - Scott Anderson, the 2011 Skip Barber National Champion and former MAZDASPEED Motorsports Development scholarship recipient, headed into the second straight Canadian stop on the 2013 Pro Mazda presented by Cooper Tires looking for podium results to highlight

the speed he has shown in his rookie campaign. On Saturday, a caution filled race at the flowing Canadian Tire Motorsports Park (formerly Mosport) left Anderson dashing for fourth place in a five lap sprint to the flag while Sunday proved a breakthrough for the team with a second place result in a tight battle among the lead group.

"Mosport was my best race weekend yet," smiles the fourth year racer. "With a fourth and a second place finish, it was both good for points and I got my first podium. It took a lot longer then I was expecting, but it felt good to finally get a top three finish."

Anderson and the #44 Juncos Racing/Laser Nail Centers/Neuropathy Testing Center/Foot Surgery Center of Northern Colorado Pro Mazda were looking for some redemption following a challenging stop on the Streets of Toronto. This time out Anderson used his past experience at Canadian Tire Motorsports Park to stay at the sharp end of the field throughout the weekend and earn a well-deserved podium result.



"We showed excellent speed at Toronto the week before," continues Anderson. "But I had contact in both races which put us laps down. This result felt great for the team and me. I want to thank the Juncos Racing guys for their hard work. They have been putting in tons of effort to get the car quick and get me up to speed in my rookie season as well."

With just a couple of weeks before the next rounds of racing taking place at the Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course, Anderson will be busy with testing duties. On Wednesday, Anderson will get the opportunity to pilot the Bryan Herta Racing Indy Lights car at Putnum Park, located just west of Indianapolis, IN. The test opportunity is part of the Skip Barber Championship prize package Anderson was awarded. That test will be followed by more testing in the Pro Mazda car as the team looks to end the second half of the season strong.

"I think it's fair to say that we should be a regular contender for podiums and wins the rest of the season," states Anderson. "That's definitely the goal. There's no reason we shouldn't be on the podium for the remaining six races."

**About Scott Anderson:**

Scott is an expert skier from Fort Collins, Colorado and a past MAZDASPEED Motorsports Development scholarship winner having won the 2011 Skip Barber National Championship Presented by Mazda (six wins). In the 2012 Cooper Tires USF2000 Championship powered by Mazda, Scott scored two wins, a pole position and set a new lap record (Road America) on his way to finishing third in the season's championship. Scott is backed by Laser Nail Centers, Neuropathy Testing Centers of Colorado and Foot Surgery Center of Northern Colorado and is a Derek Daly Academy managed driver.
