## SCOTT ANDERSON RETURNS TO INDY LIGHTS

*"Third year Indy Lights pilot to run road and street courses for Schmidt Peterson Motorsports with continued support from Hull & Knarr."*



**Fort Collins, Colorado** - Scott Anderson returns to the Mazda Road To Indy for a sixth consecutive season as he takes the wheel of the #77 Schmidt Peterson Motorsport Indy Lights car this weekend at the season opener in St. Petersburg, Florida. Fresh off of a full day of pre-season testing at Barber Motorsports Park, Anderson is set to take to a partial schedule that will see him run road and street courses for the multi-time Indy Lights Champions.

"After my longest off-season out of a car yet, and not being sure if I'd even have a ride, it feels awesome to be back," smiles Anderson. "I'm very happy to be back with Schmidt Peterson Motorsports for another season. With the lack of testing this winter it'll be nice to be in a familiar place, and we can work on the things we learned from last season. I'm also back with a familiar sponsor, Hull and Knarr. This season wouldn't have happened without them so I'm extremely thankful for their support."

Throughout the 2015 season, Anderson, along with Schmidt Peterson team principal, Sam Schmidt, put the Hull & Knarr program into action providing funding to kick off Scott's 2016 campaign. Working with major companies throughout the Indy Lights and IndyCar paddock, H&K continue to provide critical corporate tax support to companies looking to make the most of current research and development tax credit programs.

For Anderson and the #77 Hull & Knarr, Indy Lights entry, the 2016 Indy Lights Presented by Cooper Tires season begins March 11-13 with two rounds in St. Petersburg, Florida. Scott will continue to get support from Anderson Podiatry Centers of Colorado.

**ABOUT SCOTT:** An expert skier and avid outdoor enthusiast, the Fort Collins, Colorado resident is on the third and final step of the Mazda Road To Indy. Anderson was the recipient of the MAZDASPEED Motorsports Development Scholarship after winning the 2011 BFGoodrich/Skip Barber National Championship Presented by Mazda. In 2012, Anderson competed in the Cooper Tires USF2000 Championship powered by Mazda winning two races. In 2013, Scott raced in the ProMazda Championship Presented by Cooper Tires with Juncos Racing. In 2014, Anderson completed his rookie season in Indy Lights with Fan Force United. In 2015, Scott completed his sophomore season in Indy Lights with a new team; Schmidt Peterson Motorsports. 2016 sees Scott in the driver's seat for a second season at Schmidt Peterson Motorsports, running road and street courses.
