Fort Collins, Colorado - Scott Anderson, driver of the #77 Schmidt Peterson Motorsport (SPM) Indy Lights car completed all the laps of this weekend's Firestone Grand Prix of St. Petersburg, as the world witnessed the debut of the new era of Indy Lights. With warm, dry conditions throughout the Saturday and Sunday rounds of racing action, Scott experienced his first laps of

competition in a turbo charged race car. The team did a fantastic job preparing the car for the first rounds of the championship.



"Both races this weekend were pretty much dictated by a bad qualifying session," comments Anderson. "I was able to move up at the start of both races, but once things settled after the first lap or two it was extremely hard to make any passes happen. I think we had a great car for race two especially, but I couldn't do much with it being stuck behind a slower car. We made some great progress developing the setup so I think if we can really nail down qualifying at Long Beach we should be able to fight for podiums. I want to thank Hull & Knarr for their support and the Schmidt Peterson Motorsports guys for the awesome job they did this weekend."

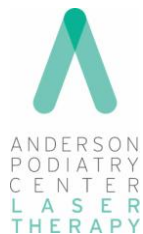
